FIRST ROMANIAN SECURITY SUMMIT

BUCHAREST UNDER SPOTLIGHT - NEW CENTER OF SECURITY IN EASTERN EUROPE

The First Romanian Security Summit marked the beginning of a new era in Eastern Europe's security industry. The regional event brought together manufacturers, integrators, distributors, and experts in a unique format that had not existed in this part of Europe before, making it the largest security technology fair with 2,700 visitors. Participants particularly praised the flawless organization, diverse program, and professional, inspiring atmosphere that encouraged networking, business deals, and the exchange of experiences and knowledge

The First Romanian Security Summit marked a new phase in Eastern Europe's security industry. It created a much-needed regional event that brought together leading manufacturers, integrators, distributors, and experts in a format that had not existed in this part of Europe before. Like a rolling train of

innovation, the Summit embarked on its first journey through Bucharest, guiding participants along a path of experiences, knowledge, and business opportunities. It established itself as the region's largest security technology fair, attracting 2,700 visitors whose energy filled every corner of the exhibition and conference halls. The event was held at the modern Romexpo Exhibition Centre, which added a practical touch.

Constructive Partnership

The event was organized as a joint effort between a&s Adria magazine, which has been hosting the ten-year Adria Security Summit series—the largest security industry gathering in the Adriatic region—and ARTS, an association uniting key Romanian stakeholders in technical security. ARTS runs its own training and expertise center and publishes the specialized magazine ALARMA, providing



solutions and information in the private security sector.

This collaboration has built a strong link between Southeast and Eastern Europe, reinforcing a common goal: to professionalize the industry, standardize practices, and create a platform for regional businesses to grow, network, and support one another. Furthermore, the summit was organized in partnership with the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations, the General Inspectorate of the Romanian Police, Messe Frankfurt, and the Romania-Israel Chamber of Commerce and Industry. These partnerships added institutional and international credibility to the event, ensuring high professional standards and fostering trust among participants.

Range of Sponsors

The Romanian Security Summit 2025 brought together an impressive array of sponsors and exhibitors, who further enhanced the event's professional and technological scope through their presence and solutions. A Recognized Model

The event in Bucharest drew heavily from the Adria Security Summit model—featuring a unified exhibition area, a targeted professional audience, and a focus on networking and business deals. From the start, it was evident that the venue was carefully designed to promote direct contacts, idea exchange, and real business benefits, unlike large fairs without a specific audience. Many Romanian companies and well-known international brands that have participated in the Adria Security Summit for years acknowledged the high quality of the organization and the standards that were carried over to the new event. The message was clear—Eastern Europe has been waiting a long time for this format, and it now finally has its central regional security industry summit.

Fatima Elleouet, Global Strategic Industries Manager at Alcatel-Lucent Enterprise, emphasized the importance of „Making Resilience and Security a Priority." Daniel Kaminski, a security consultant, offered an expert analysis titled „The Increase in Security Guards' Salaries Necessitates Changes to the Security Model," and Gerard Gumprecht, Director of Global Sales at Primion Group, delivered a presentation titled „The Future is Connected: Cybersecurity & IoT Strategies for Cross-Industry Innovation." 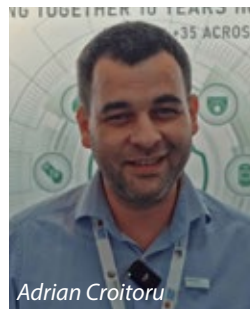
hensive insight into the current solutions, challenges, and innovations in the sector.

Among the distinguished winners were Alcatel-Lucent Enterprise with its OmniVista Network Advisor platform, awarded for the most innovative product; AIM in the access control solutions category; Ajax with its EN54-line addressable fire alarm system; AI Center with its video surveillance platform for advanced analytical functions; DVC for META AI cameras in the intrusion detection category; Bosch's PRAESENSA system as the leading IP PA/VA solution; Magus CC, an integrated command and control platform; and Axis Cybersecurity as the best cybersecurity concept in the competition. Overall, the first Romanian Security Summit met expectations and, at the same time, set a standard that will be difficult to surpass. 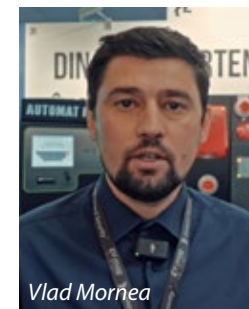

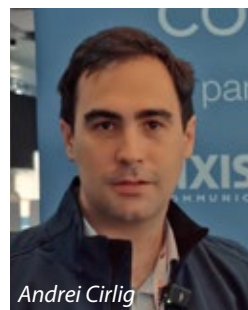

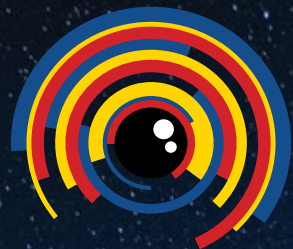
